Bluegill

Whitebass and Yellow Stripes

Whitebass and Yellow Stripes are starting to slow down. You can catch them on rooster tails and jigging spoons on main lake river points and main lake river island points in 20-30 feet of water.

Bass

Top water fishing is just starting back in the bays and main lake points. During the day, small crank baits and spinner baits on gravel and rock banks are producing nice fish.

Crappie

Crappie fishing is just starting for the Fall. Right now a few can be caught on main lake brushpiles in 15-20 feet of water with minnows. Also try deep brush piles in the middle of bays in 10-12 feet of water.
