**Lake Levels ...** As of this morning both lakes approximately 2.25 feet below summer pool and on a steady drawdown over the next several days. **Water Clarity and Temperature ...** on Kentucky Lake ranges from light stain in some of the creeks with the main lake clear. The lake is very fishable. Barkley is lightly stained and the lake is very fishable. Surface water temps on both lakes are in the high 60's.

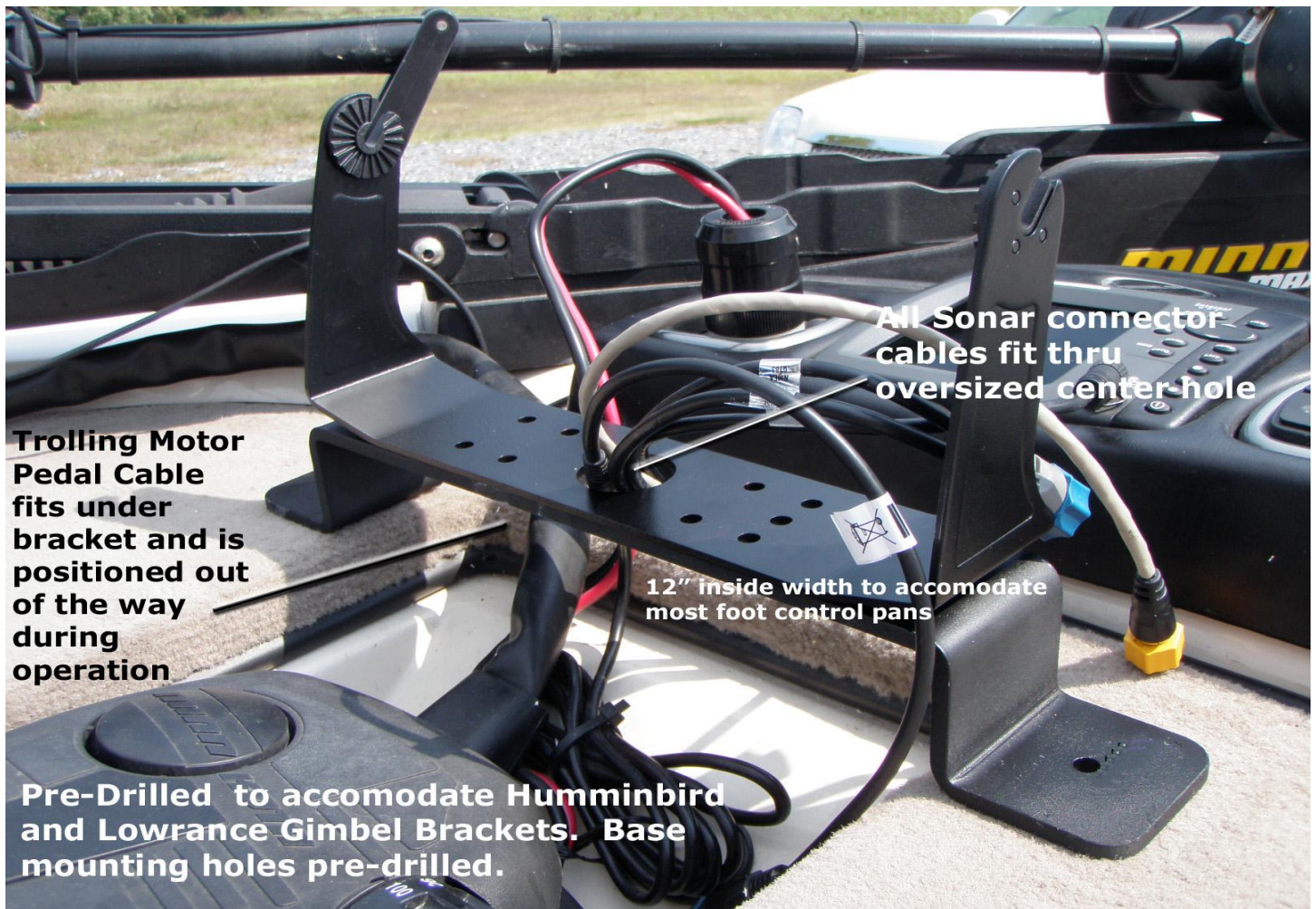

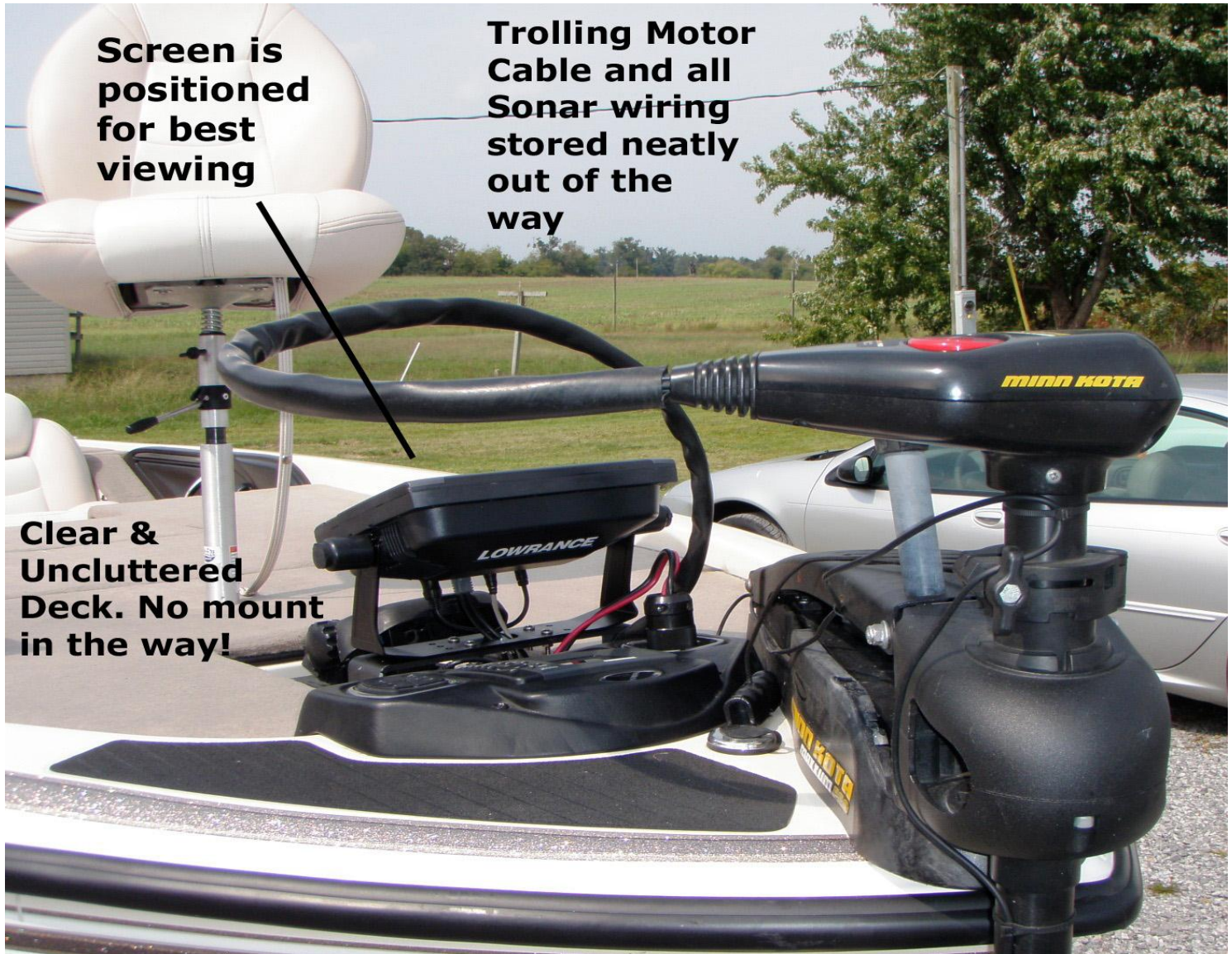
