Lake Conditions

This week both lakes are about 2 feet below summer pool and falling. TVA has been opening and closing gates at random to syphon off excess water coming in from the south and there is significant current in the upper lake. Both lakes range from cloudy in some of the creeks with the main lake and larger bays generally clear. Surface water temps on both lakes are in the 50 degree range.

Weather Outlook

Today...Mostly cloudy in the morning then clearing. Areas of frost and patchy fog in the morning. Highs in the mid 40s. Calm winds.

Tonight...Clear in the evening then becoming mostly cloudy. Lows in the mid 30s. Calm winds.

Saturday...Mostly cloudy. Highs in the lower 50s. Calm winds.

Saturday Night...Mostly cloudy. Patchy fog after midnight. Lows in the upper 30s. Calm winds.

One of my clients from Missouri stopped by the house to show me some nice bass he'd caught on jerk baits on the east side at the mouth of the bays. He said a 20 second pause between jerks was the ticket. The bass were fat and feeding on shad.
